Dear Resident, Family Member/Loved One,

We had one asymptomatic employee test positive for COVID-19 today, 8/5/20, during universal testing who will be off work until 10 days have passed and 72 hours from symptom cessation if symptoms occur.

Please know, every resident tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19 during last week's round of testing. There are currently no residents on the PUI unit, with symptoms, either.

We continue to screen all employees daily and employees have been informed to report to Infection control Nurse if they have any symptoms during their shift. If any employee reports symptoms they will leave the Facility and follow-up with our Infection Control Nurse for testing and return to work guidelines.

Our facility continues to have an adequate supply of PPE, but we are using it on a crisis/contingency plan according to CDC and CMS. All employees are wearing face masks universally while in the building.

We continue to follow COVID-19 policy and procedures including increased hand hygiene, increased sanitation of high touch surfaces and monitoring of employees, essential visitors, and residents

We are testing employees weekly for COVID-19, and will continue weekly. We tested 234 employees this week. The testing from this week has 183 results back. **We have 182 negatives and 1 positive.**

We are working hard on quick identification of any COVID-19 cases so that employees can be kept out of work and residents may be placed in appropriate zone for the care that they need.
