Dear Resident/ Loved One,

Facility COVID-19 Update:

We had 1 asymptomatic resident who tested positive for COVID-19 on 09/10/2020 and was transferred to the COVID-19 unit with dedicated staff where they will reside for 10 days and 24 hours from symptom cessation if symptoms occur, according to the CDC guidelines. This asymptomatic resident was found during our universal testing due to an outbreak within the facility.

Our facility is currently in an “outbreak” as defined by CMS. An outbreak is defined by CMS as a new COVID-19 infection in any healthcare personnel or any nursing home-onset COVID-19 infection in a resident. We will continue to test all residents and staff every 3 to 7 days until testing identifies no new cases of COVID-19 infection among staff or residents for a period of at least 14 days since the most recent positive.

Our facility continues to have an adequate supply of PPE, but we are using it on a crisis/contingency plan according to CDC and CMS to preserve it. All employees are wearing face masks universally while in the building, and using eye protection whenever a staff member is within 6 feet of a resident or providing direct care. Full isolation including gowns, gloves, masks and eye protection are being used on all units for direct patient care.

We continue to follow COVID-19 policy and procedures including increased hand hygiene, increased sanitation of high touch surfaces and monitoring of employees, essential visitors, and residents to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

To review: We now have 4 residents in the COVID-19 positive unit with dedicated staff on an isolated unit.

We will not be allowing in person visits during an outbreak as per the Arizona Department of Health Services guidance, but we will continue to offer window visits and face time visits etc.

During our universal testing this week we tested 239 employees, 236 negative 1 positive and 2 pending. We have also tested 173 residents, 171 negative, 1 positive and 1 pending. Thank you for your support during this Pandemic.
