Dear Resident, Family Member/Loved One,

Facility COVID-19 Update:

Great news!!! All employees and residents continue to be negative for COVID-19. We continue to be out of “outbreak” status. The county positivity rate for staff testing continues to be in the “green” status and our next testing dates are October 25th-27th.

Our facility continues to have an adequate supply of PPE, but we are using some of it on a crisis/contingency plan according to CDC and CMS to preserve it. All employees are wearing face masks universally while in the building, and using eye protection whenever a staff member is within 6 feet of a resident or providing direct care. Full isolation including gowns, gloves, masks and eye protection are being used our monitoring unit for direct patient care.

We continue to follow COVID-19 policy and procedures including increased hand hygiene, increased sanitation of high touch surfaces and monitoring of employees, essential visitors, and residents to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

To review: We have **NO** residents in the COVID-19 positive unit.

*Our in person visits (both outdoor and indoor) have begun and will continue as long as we are not in outbreak status. We will allow these visits by appointment. Any visitors that do not adhere to required infection control practices will be asked to leave.

*All visitations will be coordinated by the facility’s “Visitation Coordinator.” Visitation may be scheduled by calling the Visitation Coordinator at 520-296-6181 Ext. 5033 between the hours of 8:00 am and 3:00 pm Monday through Friday.

- The Facility visitation is set for 7 days a week between the hours of 8:00 am and 11 am and 1pm and 4pm.
- Essential visitors may visit between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.

We will be requiring a negative COVID PCR or antigen test weekly for any Designated Essential Visitor. We will notify you if the frequency changes, otherwise please contact Da Armenta RN Infection Preventionist at 520-904-2306 if you have any questions.
